## KHVICHA KVARATSKHELIA "EA SPORTS FC PLAYER OF THE MONTH" FOR SEPTEMBER

The award will be presented to Napoli forward in the pre-match of Napoli vs Lecce

The **EA SPORTS FC Player Of The Month** award for September has been assigned to Napoli player **Khvicha Kvaratskhelia**. The trophy will be presented during the pre-match of Napoli vs Lecce, scheduled for Saturday 26th October 2024 at 3.00pm at the "Diego Armando Maradona" stadium in Naples.

The fans' votes on http://serieapotm.easports.com/, combined with individual statistical data, determined Khvicha Kvaratskhelia as the winner, beating champions like Bremer (Juventus), Castro (Bologna), Cutrone (Como), Dimarco (Inter), Pulisic (Milan).

The six best players of the month have been selected taking into account the advanced analysis of Stats Perform, created from the tracking data recorded with the Hawk-Eye system. The rating system, patented in 2010 with K-Sport and scientifically validated, considers not only statistical data and technical events, but also positional data. This makes it possible to analyse crucial aspects such as movement without the ball and thus optimal movements, game choices, and the contribution to the technical and physical efficiency of the team, which allow for an objective and qualitative evaluation of the performance.

For the final calculation were considered the matchdays from 4 to 6 of Serie A 2024/2025.

"The many votes received on the EA SPORTS platform show the desire of many fans to participate in the Serie A choices – said Lega Serie A CEO **Luigi De Siervo** –. Kvaratskhelia is a symbol of Napoli and of our entire league, an extraordinary player who can always decide a match with his quality plays, as well as a positive figure for youngsters, an emblem of the commitment and determination needed to achieve ambitious results. With his fourth Player Of The Month success, the Napoli winger joins Paulo Dybala among the players who have won this trophy the most times".
