

**Cagliari - Bologna**

29 October 2024



- Since a 1-1 draw in July 2020, each of the last six encounters between Cagliari and Bologna in Serie A have been won by the home team (three wins each).
- Cagliari have won each of their last five home matches against Bologna in Serie A; they've only enjoyed a longer run of consecutive home wins against an opponent just twice in their history in the competition: Ascoli (6, between 1980 and 2007) and Sampdoria (8 between 1970 and 1982).
- After winning each of the first three Serie A matches played against Cagliari between Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, Bologna are winless in the last four (D1 L3).
- After a 2-2 draw in the last matchday against Genoa, Bologna have drawn six of their first eight Serie A games of a single campaign for only the second time in their history after 1989-90. Considering the first nine games of the season, however, they have never recorded seven draws in the top-flight.
- Bologna have not won any of their last seven Serie A matches played on Tuesday (D3 L4), failing to score in four of these; they had won each of the previous five matches played on this day of the week in the competition.
- Cagliari won their last Serie A home game (3-2 vs Torino), after failing to win in their previous seven (D4 L3); the Sardinians could record consecutive home wins in the competition for the first time since between October and November 2023 against Frosinone and Genoa.
- Bologna have scored exactly two goals in each of their last three Serie A away games (W1 D2); they have not done so in at least four successive away games in the competition with at least two goals scored since February-April 2004 (run of six).
- Zito Luvumbo's first goal in Serie A came against Bologna in September 2023; the Emilian side could become the first opponent against whom the Sardinian striker has scored more than one goal against in the top-flight.
- Nikola Moro has provided six assists in Serie A - three of these for Riccardo Orsolini - including the last one against Genoa; five of these have arrived in away games and since his debut in the competition in 2022-23. Indeed, only four midfielders have provided more assists away from home than the Croatian in that time: Aleksey Miranchuk, Mario Pasalic (7 each), Luis Alberto and Christian Pulisic (6 each).
- After not scoring in his first six appearances against Cagliari in Serie A, Riccardo Orsolini has been involved in three goals in his last five matches against the Sardinians in the top-flight (2 goals, 1 assist), netting last time against them in January. Indeed, he scored in Bologna's most recent match against Genoa and could find the net in two games in a row in the league for the first time since last February.



## Lecce - Hellas Verona

- Hellas Verona are unbeaten in their last nine Serie A matches against Lecce (W6 D3), after they had lost three of the previous four (W1). The Gialloblu have enjoyed a run of at least 10 consecutive matches without defeat against an opponent in the top-flight only against Fiorentina (11 between 1984 and 1989) and Pisa (10 between 1968 and 1988).
- Lecce have failed to score in five of their last six Serie A matches against Hellas Verona - against no opponent have they failed to score more often in the last four Italian top-flight seasons they've participated in (since 2019-20) - five also against Torino and Inter, but both across seven games.
- Hellas Verona have won - keeping a clean sheet - in each of their last three Serie A away games against Lecce, after they failed to win in the first six (D2 L4); the Gialloblu have never enjoyed a longer run of consecutive away wins against an opponent in their history in the competition.
- Lecce have failed to score in seven of their nine Serie A games this season, more than any other team in the big five European leagues in 2024-25.
- Lecce have lost four of their last six home games in Serie A (W1 D1), as many defeats as they had suffered in their previous 13 home games in the competition (W3 D6).
- Hellas Verona are the only team in Serie A this season yet to draw a game (W3 L6), while they have also conceded 21 goals - including 16 in the last five games - in this campaign, more than any other team. Meanwhile, Lecce are the lowest goalscorers overall (3 goals).
- Hellas Verona have recorded three defeats in their last three Serie A away games; in 2024 they have registered eight defeats away from home in Serie A from 14 away games played, fewer only than Lecce (9).
- Hellas Verona have conceded seven goals in the first 15 minutes in Serie A this season (a record in the current campaign); however, Lecce have not yet found the net in the first 15 minutes of the first half.
- Nikola Krstovic - who has not scored in his last four Serie A appearances - has scored only in home games in Serie A this season and needs just one more goal to match his total tally in home games in the last campaign (3).
- After his goal against Atalanta in his last appearance in Serie A, Amin Sarr could score a goal in consecutive league games for the first time since between March and April 2022, doing so for Heerenveen.

**Milan - Napoli**

- Milan have won three of the last five Serie A encounters against Napoli (D1 L1), as many wins as in the 22 previous league meetings with the Partenopei (W3 D8 L11).
- Napoli are unbeaten in eight of the last nine Serie A away games against Milan (W5 D8), losing the most recent, a 0-1 defeat on 11 February 2024 (goal by Theo Hernández); the last time the Rossoneri enjoyed at least two consecutive home league wins against the Partenopei dates back to the period between 2000 and 2008 (three on that occasion).
- Milan have won only one of the last nine meetings with Napoli played in the first half of a Serie A campaign (D2 L6): a 3-1 win on 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2020 (thanks to an Ibrahimovic brace and Hauge's goal for the Rossoneri, Mertens for the Partenopei).
- Among the sides that have played more than one Serie A game on a Tuesday, Napoli have posted the highest goals per game average - 2.4 (31 goals in 13 matches); on the other hand, Milan have failed to find the net in their three most recent league games played on this day of the week, but have kept a clean sheet in three of their last four (the only exception being a 0-4 defeat against Lazio on 24 January 2023).
- AC Milan have registered a clean sheet in three of their last five Serie A games (as many as they managed in the previous 14) and could keep a shutout in two consecutive matches in the competition for the first time since last March (against Lazio and Empoli).
- AC Milan have won three home games in a row in Serie A without conceding a goal for the first time since May 2022 and have not done better in the competition since a run of four between March and May 2014.
- Napoli are unbeaten in their last three Serie A away games, having won two of them (D1), as many as they had recorded in their previous 13 away from home league games (W2 D5 L6).
- Christian Pulisic has been involved in at least one goal in each of his last seven league games (five goals and three assists); only one Milan player has been directly involved in at least one goal (goals and assists) in more consecutive appearances in a single Serie A season since 2004/05: Zlatan Ibrahimovic (10 between October and December 2010).
- Theo Hernández will miss the match against Napoli due to suspension;. In the last three seasons across all competitions (since 2022/23), Milan have won 54% of their games with the French player on the pitch (54 out of 101), scoring 1.9 goals on average – without him, however, the Rossoneri's win rate falls to 29% (4 out of 14), scoring 0.8 goals on average.
- Matteo Politano has scored five goals against Milan in Serie A, against no other opponent he has done better in the competition (five also against Genoa); in addition, the Napoli striker has scored five away goals at San Siro; in the last 10 seasons only Fabio Quagliarella (six) and Domenico Berardi (seven) have done better playing away from home in the top flight in this stadium.

**Empoli - Inter**

- Inter have won more matches against Empoli in Serie A than any other side has managed: 25 out of 32 previous meetings (D3 L4), including 12 successes in the 13 most recent encounters (L1).
- Inter have kept a clean sheet in their last three league games against Empoli and have never enjoyed a longer such run against this opponent in Serie A.
- Inter have kept a clean sheet in their last nine away games against Empoli in Serie A (W8 D1), already the longest away run of consecutive clean sheets by a single team against an opponent in the history of Serie A; the Tuscans' last goal at home against the Nerazzurri in the competition dates back to 30 April 2006 (an own goal by Marco Materazzi in a 1-0 win).
- In 2024, Empoli have failed to score in nine of their 14 home games in Serie A (including each of the last four), more than any other team in the competition. The Tuscan club have failed to score in five home games in a row in Serie A only once in their history: between September and November 2016.
- Inter have won the most away games in Serie A in 2024: 10 wins in 14 away from home games (D3 L1) – despite they winning only three of their last seven away games in the competition.
- Empoli have not won any of their last four league games (D2 L2) and have not recorded a longer run without a win in Serie A since the period between November 2023 and January 2024 (eight).
- Inter have conceded 13 goals in Serie A this term after only conceding five goals by matchday 9 of the last Serie A season; moreover, the Nerazzurri conceded their 13th goal only by MD27 in the previous league campaign.
- No player in the current Empoli squad has ever scored a goal in Serie A against Inter; Roberto D'Aversa, on the other hand, after winning his first match as coach in the top-flight against the Nerazzurri (Inter-Parma 0-1 on 15 September 2018, goal by Dimarco), registered five defeats and two draws in the following seven matches.
- In the 2016/17 season, Federico Dimarco played 12 Serie A games for Empoli; against his former team he scored three goals in the competition, more than against any other opponent.
- Lautaro Martinez has scored just three goals in Serie A this term: he had already scored 11 goals by matchday 9 last season; only against three teams he faced at least twice has the Argentine striker failed to score or assist: Empoli, Roma and Sassuolo.

**Venezia - Udinese**

- Udinese have won four of their last five games against Venezia in Serie A (L1), including the previous three, after failing to win their first five games against the lagoon side in the competition (D3 L2).
- Venezia are unbeaten in four of their five home games against Udinese in Serie A (W3 D1), but have lost their most recent one: 1-2 at the Penzo on 10 April 2022.
- Venezia have lost two of their first three home games in Serie A this season (W1) and have only suffered at least three defeats in their first four Serie A home games of the season in 1949/50 (4).
- After a run of five away games without defeat in Serie A (W3 D2), Udinese have lost their most recent two, without scoring, and have not lost more in a row since the period between April and May 2023, when they reached five away defeats in a row, four of these matches without scoring.
- Venezia, after the draw in Monza, are looking to remain unbeaten for two games in a row in Serie A for the first time this season; in fact, the last time they do so was in the last three matches of the 21/22 tournament (W1, D2).
- Udinese have won five of their first nine games in Serie A this season (D1 L3); in the last campaign, after the same number of games, the Bianconeri had not yet recorded a single victory (D6, L3).
- Venezia is one of the two teams, together with Cagliari, to have conceded the most goals from corner kicks in Serie A this season (both five), while only Fiorentina (four) has scored more than Udinese (three) from this game situation.
- Udinese have scored five headed goals in Serie A this season, more than any other team and more than they had done in 2023/24 (four) – Lorenzo Lucca has scored three of those goals, no one has scored more in the current season, equal to Mateo Retegui and Marcus Thuram.
- Gaetano Oristanio (one goal and one assist in his last three Serie A appearances) is the player in Serie A this season with the most dribbles completed (19).
- Among Italian Serie A players who have scored more than 10 goals in all competitions since last season, Lorenzo Lucca (15 – September 2000) is the youngest – the Udinese striker found the net in the previous game but has never scored in two consecutive Serie A appearances.



## Atalanta - Monza

30 October 2024



- Atalanta are the only team to have a 100% win rate against Monza in Serie A: four wins in four previous matches, with an aggregate score of 12-3.
- Monza have never drawn in seven away games against Lombard sides in Serie A (W2 L5), losing the previous four.
- Atalanta have won each of their last five home games against Monza between Serie A and Serie B, having won only two of their first seven home games against the Brianza team in these competitions (D3 L2).
- Monza won their last away Serie A game (3-0 against Hellas Verona), after a streak of eight away games without a win in the competition (D4 L4); the last time the Brianza team recorded two wins in a row away from home in the league dates back to between February and March (against Salernitana and Genoa).
- Atalanta have scored the most goals in Serie A this season overall (24 goals scored) and also in home games (16 goals): in the first 10 Serie A games of the season, the Nerazzurri have scored more than 24 goals only once, in 2019/20 (30 in that case).
- Atalanta have scored five goals from outside the box this season (a record in the current campaign), including four in their last three home games in Serie A.
- This match is between the team who have recorded the highest Expected Goals value (Atalanta, 19) and the one with the lowest xG (Monza, 5.9) in this championship. The "Dea" is also the team who have taken the highest number of shots on target (58) while the Brianza club have the fewest (21) in Serie A 2024/25.
- Mateo Retegui has scored 10 goals in his first nine games in Serie A this season: only one player has found the net more often in his teams' first 10 games in the competition in the three points for a win era (Luca Toni, 12 for Fiorentina in 2005/06).
- Although Monza is the opponent against whom Ademola Lookman has provided the most assists in Serie A (four), the Brianza team is also the team against which the Atalanta striker has played the most matches in the competition without scoring (four).
- Milan Djuric has scored three goals in Serie A this season, none via the head: the striker has never scored more goals with his feet in a single season in the tournament (three also in 2023/24, out of nine overall).

**Juventus - Parma**

- Juventus are unbeaten in 13 of their last 14 matches against Parma in Serie A (W10 D3), winning the previous four (already a record for consecutive wins for the Bianconeri against the Emilians in the league) – the only success for the Ducali in this period dates back to 11 April 2015 (1-0 with a goal from José Mauri at the Tardini).
- Among the teams against which Juventus have always scored in home games in Serie A, Parma is the one that the Bianconeri have faced the most times: 26 home matches, scoring 65 goals (2.5 on average per match).
- Juventus have won all of their last seven matches against Parma played the first half of the Serie A season, with an aggregate score of 21-2.
- Juventus have drawn 15 of 29 league matches in 2024 (W10, L4), a record in the Big-5 European leagues; only once have the Bianconeri recorded more draws in a single calendar year in Serie A: 17 in 1956.
- Juventus have won eight of the last nine matches played on Wednesdays in Serie A (1L), scoring 20 goals in the period (2.2 on average per match).
- Parma have not won any of their last 18 Serie A away games (D8 L10) and have only once recorded a longer away run without a win in the competition, between May 2007 and September 2009 (23).
- Juventus conceded four goals in the last match against Inter, as many as they had conceded in the previous 10 Serie A matches. Of the five goals conceded by the Bianconeri in this championship, only one came from open play (Mkhitaryan's), the fewest in the current tournament.
- Dusan Vlahovic has been involved in 19 goals in his last 21 matches against newly promoted teams in Serie A (16 goals and three assists), after not having been involved in any goals in his first 12 matches against these teams in the tournament.
- With a brace against Inter, Kenan Yildiz has already equaled his number of goals scored last season in Serie A (two) – the player born in 2005 is looking for his first goal at the Allianz Stadium in Serie A, his four goals so far have all come away from home.
- Parma's last six Serie A goals have been scored by six different players: Pontus Almqvist, Antoine Hainaut, Dennis Man, Hernani, Ange-Yoan Bonny and Gabriel Charpentier.

**Genoa - Fiorentina**

- Fiorentina are the opponents against which Genoa have recorded the most draws in Serie A: 39. In fact, the Rossoblu have drawn 12 of their last 19 matches against the Viola in the competition (W2 L5).
- Fiorentina are unbeaten in 12 of their last 13 matches against Genoa in Serie A (W4 D8), the Grifone's only success in this period came in September 2019 (2-1 at Ferraris).
- Fiorentina have won their last two away matches against Genoa in the league, and have never achieved three consecutive successes away from home against the Grifone in Serie A.
- Although Genoa have only lost two of their last eight most home matches in Serie A (W3 D3), they are yet to win on home soil in the league this season (D3 L2). In their history, the Grifone have failed to win their first six home matches of the season in the competition only in 1956-57, 2017-18 and 2021-22.
- Fiorentina have won their last three league matches, scoring 13 goals (4.3 on average). Indeed, they last won more games in a row in Serie A between February - April 2023 (five in that case).
- Fiorentina have lost only one of their last six Serie A away games (W3 D2) and have not conceded a goal in their last recent two. The last time that the Viola recorded three consecutive clean sheets away from home in the competition was in April 2023.
- Since the start of September, no team has earned fewer points than Genoa in Serie A (two in seven games, level with Lecce) or conceded more goals than the Grifone in the competition (18, alongside Hellas Verona).
- Andrea Pinamonti has scored three goals against Fiorentina in Serie A with three different sides (Frosinone, Empoli and Sassuolo), only against Roma (five) and Bologna (four) has he netted more goals in the competition.
- All four of Moise Kean's league goals this season have come in the first half, with only Mateo Retegui (five) scoring more in the first half in Serie A.
- Genoa are the team against which Cristiano Biraghi has been involved in the most goals in Serie A: six, three goals and three assists. Only two defenders have been involved in more goals against a single opponent in the competition since Opta started to collect this data (2004-05): Alessandro Florenzi (eight against Genoa) and Christian Maggio (seven against Palermo).



**Como - Lazio**

- Lazio have won their last two Serie A meetings with Como (in the 2002-03 season), after the Lombardy were unbeaten in their three previous matches against the Biancocelesti in the competition (W2 D1).
- Lazio won their last Serie A away match against Como in November 2002 (3-1 with a brace from Claudio Lopez and a goal from Diego Simeone), after having achieved just one success in their first seven away games against the Larians in the top-flight (D2 L4).
- Como are unbeaten at home in Serie A this term (W1 D2): the last time they avoided defeat in their first four home games of a Serie A season was in 1986-87 (one win and three draws on that occasion).
- Lazio have won their last six Serie A matches against newly promoted teams, while they can record their longest such streak since January 2020 (13 on that occasion).
- Como have nine points in Serie A this season, five more than during their last participation in Serie A after nine games (four in 2002-03). However, the Larians have not recorded a single clean sheet at this stage of the season for the third time in their Serie A history, after 1981-82 and 2002-03, editions in which they also conceded on their 10th match.
- Lazio have won six of their last seven matches in all competitions (L1), scoring 17 goals in this period (2.4 on average per match). The Biancocelesti could also record three successive clean sheets across all competitions for the first time this calendar year.
- Lazio have lost three of their four Serie A away games this season (W1), while the only time in the last 55 years in which they have suffered four defeats in their first five away games played in a Serie A season was in 2015-16.
- Andrea Belotti has scored 31 goals in midweek Serie A matches (between Monday and Friday) – only Francesco Totti (33), Paulo Dybala (32) and Ciro Immobile (32) have netted more in the competition in matches played between on these days of the week.
- Alberto Moreno is one of three players to have started all nine matches for Como in Serie A this term, alongside Patrick Cutrone and Gabriel Strefezza - the Spaniard, however, is the one with the most minutes played (775).
- No player has provided more assists than Nuno Tavares in the Big-5 European Leagues this season: seven, equal to Bukayo Saka. The last Serie A defender to have provided more in a single season was Achraf Hakimi (eight in 2020-21).



## Roma - Torino

- Torino can become the first opponents against which Roma record 70 victories in Serie A (69W 42D 47L in 158 previous matches); on the other hand, the Granata have only won more games against Fiorentina (50) than against the Giallorossi (47) in the competition.
- Roma are unbeaten in their last six Serie A matches against Torino (W4 D2), the Granata's last league success against the Giallorossi came in April 2021 (3-1 at the Olimpico Grande Torino).
- Roma have won 12 of their last 14 home games against Torino in Serie A (D1 L1), scoring 35 goals in this run (2.5 on average per match).
- After avoiding defeat in their first three away games this season (W2 D1), Paolo Vanoli's Torino have lost their last two: the last time that the Granata recorded three defeats in a row away from home in Serie A came between September - October 2022.
- Roma have lost their last two league matches - the last time they recorded three straight defeats in Serie A was between June and July 2020 under Paulo Fonseca.
- Roma have lost two of their four home games this season (W2) and have never recorded more defeats in their first five home games of the season in their Serie A history.
- Torino's 14 points in the league this season have come via four wins, two draws and three defeats: the last time the Granata earned five or more wins in their first 10 games of a Serie A season was in 1984-85 (six on that occasion).
- No team have scored more away goals than Torino in Serie A this season (10, tied with Juventus); however, they have also conceded 10 goals away from home: only Venezia (13), Como and Hellas Verona (both 11) have shipped more.
- Paulo Dybala, who has scored eight league goals against Torino, has never lost in his 19 Serie A matches against the Granata (W11 D8). In the three points for a win era, only Gianluigi Buffon (27 v Atalanta ) and Andrea Pirlo (20 v Cagliari) have played more matches against a single opponent without ever losing in the competition.
- Alieu Njie found the net last time out aged 19 years and 164 days: only Luca Mezzano (two in 1995-96) and Pinga (two in 1999-2000) have scored more than one goal in a Serie A season for Torino while aged under 20 in the three points for a win era.
