

**Cagliari – Hellas Verona**

29 November 2024



- Hellas Verona are unbeaten in their last nine Serie A matches against Cagliari (W5 D4); this is the Gialloblù's longest unbeaten streak in consecutive matches against a single opponent in the competition.
- Nine of Cagliari's 10 Serie A victories against Hellas Verona have come in home games, including each of the last five. However, the Rossoblù have not won any of their last four home matches against the Veneti in the competition (D2 L2).
- Cagliari have drawn their last two Serie A matches (against AC Milan and Genoa), last having a longer run of draws in the competition between November-December 2021 (4 under Walter Mazzarri).
- Cagliari have conceded at least two goals in each of their last six league games; only once have the Sardinians conceded multiple goals in more consecutive matches (9 between November 2019 and January 2020).
- Hellas Verona are only one of two teams, along with Le Havre, not to have yet drawn a match in Europe's big five leagues in 2024/25: four wins and nine defeats in the current tournament for the Gialloblù.
- No team has conceded more goals than Verona in Europe's five biggest leagues 2024/25 (32, as have Bochum and Montpellier). Only three teams have conceded more goals than the Gialloblù after the first 13 seasonal games of a Serie A tournament in the three points per win era (since 1994/95): Benevento (33, in 2017/18), Napoli (34, in 1997/98) and Bari (33, in 1995/96).
- Cagliari have conceded more goals from set pieces in Serie A than any other side this season (10), while Hellas Verona have conceded the most from open play (27).
- Hellas Verona are the only team yet to drop any points from a winning position in Serie A this season, while only Lazio and Atalanta (7) have won more from behind than Cagliari so far (6).
- Cagliari's Roberto Piccoli - on target in the last league match against Genoa - has 16 goals in Serie A; the striker is the only player to have scored more than 15 goals since December 2020 (his first goal in the tournament) without having provided any assists in Europe's big five leagues.
- Casper Tengstedt, who has scored four goals in this championship with just five shots on target, can become the second Danish player to score at least five goals in a Serie A season with Hellas Verona, after Preben Elkjær Larsen (on four occasions, most recently in 1987/88, seven goals).

**Como - Monza**

- After remaining unbeaten in eight consecutive matches (W5 D3) against Como in Serie B and Serie C, Monza lost the last encounter in the second-tier in April 2022 (0-2); the Brianzoli could suffer back-to-back defeats against the Larians for the first time since 1997-2009, both in the third division.
- After two consecutive wins, Como have failed to win any of their last seven Serie A matches (D2 L5). Since October, the Larians are the only team yet to register a win in the league.
- Como are, along with Bochum and Montpellier, one of only three teams yet to have kept a clean sheet in the big five European leagues this season. In fact, only twice in their history have the Larians failed to keep a clean sheet in the first 14 Serie A matches of a season: in 1981/82 and 2022/03 (relegated at the end of both seasons).
- Como have lost their last two home league games, after going unbeaten in the first three of the current season. The Larians could suffer three consecutive defeats at home in Serie A for the first time since November-December 2002 (four in that case, including a forfeited loss against Udinese).
- Monza has won only one of their last 22 Serie A matches (D9 L12) - a 3-0 victory at Hellas Verona last October - and during this period (30th matchday of last season), Monza is the team that has earned the fewest points (only 12) among the clubs that have been in both of the last two seasons' leagues.
- Monza have failed to score in eight of their 16 away matches played in 2024 (50% of the time); only Lecce has had more away games (11/17) without scoring in this calendar year compared to the Brianzoli.
- 38% of Monza's goals conceded in Serie A this season have been headers, the highest share in the division. However, Como are the only side yet to score a headed goal so far this term.
- Como has scored one goal for every 22 balls played in the opposition box in this Serie A season; in the current league, only Venezia (1/23), Roma (1/25), and Lecce (1/36) have a worse ratio of goals to touches in the opposition box than the Larians.
- Patrick Cutrone has not scored a goal in his last seven Serie A appearances: since the beginning of October, only Lecce's Krstovic (21) has attempted more shots than the Como striker (17) without finding the net in the topflight.
- Milan Djuric has scored 12 headed goals in Serie A, including the most recent one against Torino; in the last four seasons, among players currently active in the big five European leagues, only Robert Lewandowski (13), Erling Haaland (14), and Harry Kane (23) have scored more headers than the Monza forward.

**Milan - Empoli**

- AC Milan have won six of their last seven Serie A matches (D1) against Empoli, keeping a clean sheet in five of those games, including the last three.
- All three of Empoli's victories in their 32 Serie A encounters (D9 L20) against Milan have come at San Siro: in 2003, 2007 and the most recent in 2017.
- AC Milan have alternated between a match with at least one goal conceded and a clean sheet in their last 10 league matches; specifically, the Rossoneri have not conceded a goal in five of their last nine Serie A encounters, including the most recent against Juventus – just one fewer clean sheet than the six they recorded in the previous 23 matches played in 2024.
- AC Milan have failed to score in their last two Serie A games played at San Siro (D1 L1). The last time the Rossoneri went without a victory for more than two consecutive home games in the league was between February and April 2021 (four games), while the last time they went more than two consecutive home matches without scoring was between October and November 2017 (four games).
- AC Milan have 19 points this season (W5 D4 L3). Since the introduction of three points for a win (from the 1994/95 season), the Rossoneri have only finished in the top three once in 11 instances where they gathered fewer than 19 points after the first 12 Serie A matches – in 2012/13, when they finished third.
- Empoli have drawn their last two league matches 1-1 (against Lecce and Udinese) and could end three consecutive matches with a 1-1 draw for the first time in their Serie A history.
- Empoli have drawn their last two away matches in the league (against Parma and Lecce) and could end three consecutive away matches in Serie A in a draw for the first time since December 2021-February 2022 (four in that case).
- AC Milan is the only team yet to score a goal from outside the box in Serie A this season; the last long-range goal by the Rossoneri was back in May against Cagliari (scored by Tijjani Reijnders). Meanwhile, Empoli have had the fewest shots from outside the box in the current league season (39, 12 fewer than Milan), but from those, two goals have been scored
- Milan's Tammy Abraham has scored more Serie A goals against Empoli than any other opponent (4). Having scored against Cagliari last time out, the English striker is looking to score in consecutive league games for the first time since March 2022.
- Pietro Pellegri has already scored three goals (one in each of his last three matches) in nine games of this season – as many as in the previous two Serie A seasons, but in 42 matches with Torino. Since the introduction of three points for a win (from the 1994/95 season), only two Empoli players have scored in four consecutive league games: Francesco Tavano (2006) and Massimo Maccarone (2015).

**Bologna - Venezia**

- After going undefeated for 14 consecutive games (W7 D7) against Venezia in Serie A, Bologna have lost their last two matches and could suffer three defeats in a row against the Veneti for the first time in the competition.
- Only once in all 13 away matches played on Bologna's pitch in Serie A has Venezia managed to score more than one goal against the Felsinei: in April 1943, when the Laguna team won 2-0 in Emilia-Romagna, thanks to goals from Amedeo Degli Espositi and Lanfranco Alberico.
- Bologna lost their last league match against Lazio; Bologna are only one of three teams, among those who have taken part in the last two Serie A tournaments, to have never lost two consecutive matches in the period (since 2023/24), along with Inter and AC Milan.
- Bologna are one of only four teams - along with Lazio, Fiorentina and Juventus - not to have lost at home yet in Serie A this season (W1 D4); only twice in the three-point-per-win era (since 1994/95) have the Felsinei remained unbeaten in their first six home games in a Serie A championship: in 2002/03 and 2010/11..
- Venezia are one of the two teams - along with Roma - not yet to have won an away match in Serie A this season; the Laguna players could go without a win in their first eight away matches of the season for the ninth time in 14 Serie A championships played so far (64% of cases, including the current tournament).
- Venezia are winless in their last 14 Serie A away games (D3 L11), the longest ongoing run of any side currently in the division.
- Bologna have scored a league-high 27% of their Serie A goals from outside the box this season (4/15) – all four have come after half-time and been scored by either Jens Odgaard or Santiago Castro (two each).
- Venezia have used more different players born from 2000 onwards than any other side in Serie A this season (16), with only Parma (7540), Juventus (7403) and Hellas Verona (6262) giving more minutes to such players than Venezia (6143).
- Riccardo Orsolini has scored five Serie A goals this season; should he score against Venezia, the Bologna forward could become the first player to score more than five goals in each of the last seven (including this one) Serie A seasons and the fifth in the period in Europe's top five tournaments, after Harry Kane, Mohamed Salah, Robert Lewandowski and Kylian Mbappé.
- Venezia's Gaetano Oristanio has been involved in three goals (one goal, two assists) in his last seven league games, as many as in his previous 31 matches combined. He also has the most successful dribbles in Serie A this term (28).



Udinese - Genoa

- After remaining unbeaten in 13 consecutive matches (W6 D7) against Genoa in Serie A, Udinese lost the last match last February 2-0; the Friulians could suffer consecutive defeats against the Ligurians in the competition for the first time since 2010.
- Udinese have kept a clean sheet in nine of the last 14 home matches against Genoa in Serie A since 2009-10, more than against any other opponent in home matches in the competition.
- After having collected 10 points (W3 D1) in the first four matches of this season (2.5 on average per match), Udinese have only collected seven points (W2 D1 L6) in the following nine matches (0.8 of average). Indeed, since MD5, the Friulians only have more than Hellas Verona, Monza and Genoa (all six points).
- Udinese have earned 71% of their points in Serie A this season at home (12/17), only Venezia and Hellas Verona have a higher such proportion (both 75%).
- Genoa have drawn their last two Serie A matches and could draw three top-flight league games in a row for the first time since between December 2023 and January 2024.
- Genoa have scored 11 goals and conceded 24 in Serie A this season for a goal difference of -13 (better only than Hellas Verona and Lecce with -15 each). Indeed, in all 56 previous seasons played in Serie A, the Ligurian team has never recorded a difference between goals scored and goals conceded worse than -13 after the first 14 league matches of a Serie A campaign (-13 also in 2019-20 and 2020-21).
- Udinese are the team who have scored the most headed goals in Serie A this season (6), including one in their last game against Empoli, and are one of only three sides yet to concede a headed goal along with Napoli and Atalanta.
- Genoa are the team who have scored the highest proportion of their Serie A goals this season in the second half of the matches (73% - 8/11). Furthermore, 55% of the Rossoblù's league goals have come in the last 15 minutes of the game (6/11), the highest such proportion by a side in Serie A this season.
- With the assist for Keinan Davis' goal in their last league game against Empoli, Sandi Lovric reached 10 assists in Serie A (for 10 different teammates); in the last three seasons (since 2022-23), no Udinese player has more (10 assists also for Roberto Pereyra).
- Mario Balotelli has scored four goals against Udinese in Serie A, only against Palermo does he have more (5), including his first brace with Milan, in February 2013. Should he score, the Genoa striker, who has played only 23 minutes in Serie A so far this season, would find the net again 1792 days after his last goal (05/01/2020, with Brescia against Lazio).



Parma - Lazio

- Parma have lost each of their last nine Serie A games against Lazio, with an aggregate score of 21-4 for the Biancocelesti; it's their longest streak of successive defeats ever suffered against a single opponent in the top-flight.
- Lazio have won each of their last nine Serie A games against Parma between 2014 and 2021; only against Udinese have they gone on a longer such streak (10 wins in a row between 1998 and 2003) in their top-flight history.
- Lazio have won each of their last four Serie A away matches against Parma - only one win fewer than in all of their previous 23 games on the road against the Gialloblù in the competition (W5 D7 L11).
- Lazio have won each of their last five Serie A matches – scoring 14 goals and conceding only two in the period – the last time they recorded six successive wins in the competition was back between January and February 2021 under Simone Inzaghi.
- No team has lost more home games than Parma in Serie A this season (4/7, alongside Hellas Verona, Monza and Venezia). Furthermore, only once have the Emiliani suffered at least five defeats in their first eight top-flight home league games, doing so in 2014-15 (run of six).
- Parma and Lazio are two of the four teams to have scored the most goals from fast breaks in Serie A in 2024-25, both three goals, level with Juventus, and only less than Fiorentina (4).
- Lazio have scored the most goals in the last 30 minutes of play in Serie A this season (15), including the three goals they netted last time out against Bologna, at least five more than any other side.
- Should they win against Parma, Marco Baroni could become the fastest manager to reach 10 wins in his first time ever managing Lazio in Serie A (currently W9 D1 L3 in 13 games).
- Matteo Cancellieri, who made 20 appearances without being directly involved in any goals for Lazio in Serie A in 2022-23 – has scored two goals, against Milan and Atalanta, in his last four games at Tardini in the competition. In general, he could find the net in successive matches for the first time in the top-flight.
- Mattia Zaccagni has scored in each of his last three Serie A games against Cagliari, Monza and Bologna, and could find the net in four matches in a row for the first time in the competition, as well as equal his total in the whole of last season (6 goals in 28 appearances).

**Torino - Napoli**

- Torino went unbeaten in their two matches against Napoli last season (W1 D1), after a run of five defeats in a row, and could go at least three consecutive matches unbeaten against the Partenopei for the first time since between December 2007 and November 2012 in Serie A (run of five – W3 D2).
- Torino won the first meeting of last season's league match against Napoli (3-0); the Granata have not won their first match of the season against the Neapolitans for two straight Serie A seasons since 1984-85 and 1985-86, with Luigi Radice as coach.
- Napoli lost their last away match against Torino in Serie A (0-3 in January 2024), having won seven of their previous eight away matches against the Granata in the top-flight (D1). Indeed, only twice in the competition have the Azzurri lost two matches in a row without scoring away to the Granata, between March and December 1936 and between November 1938 and October 1939.
- After earning 11 points in the first five matchdays of this season (W3 D2), Torino collected only four in the next eight (W1 D1 L6); no team has collected fewer points in Serie A since the start of MD6 (level with Venezia).
- Torino and Napoli are two of the five teams to record four victories by a one goal margin this league season (along with Fiorentina, Inter and Udinese), only Lazio (5) boast more such wins in this Serie A season.
- Napoli have kept eight clean sheets so far, fewer only than Juventus (10) in the big five European leagues this season; in particular, the Partenopei have only conceded one goal in the first half away from home (against Inter), no team has done better (one also for Lazio, Lille and Real Madrid).
- Of the teams that have had at least 20 big chances in the big five European leagues in 2024-25, Napoli are the team that have the best conversion rate (63% - 15/24), including the one that led to the 1-0 victory last time out against Roma.
- Alessandro Buongiorno - who grew up in the youth ranks of Torino, as well as having made his first 99 appearances, with four goals, in Serie A with the Granata - intercepted 57 balls in 2024, among players in the big five European leagues only Rocco Reitz (58) of Borussia Mönchengladbach has done so more often.
- Antonio Sanabria has scored a goal in three of his last four appearances against the Partenopei in Serie A, including the two matches between Torino and Napoli last season. Indeed, should he score, Napoli will be the side against which he's scored against most often in Serie A for Torino (3 currently).
- Romelu Lukaku has been involved in nine goals (5goals, 4 assists) against Torino in Serie A, against no other team has he been involved in more goals in the competition (9 also against Genoa). Indeed, should he start against the Granata, the Belgian would be starting his 350th game in Europe's big five leagues.

**Fiorentina - Inter**

- Fiorentina have won only one of their 14 meetings with Inter in Serie A since the 2017-18 season (D5 L8); meanwhile Viola have failed to score in their last two league games against the Nerazzurri but haven't recorded a longer run of consecutive goalless matches in the competition against them since doing so between December 2007 and November 2009 (5 in a row).
- Inter have won six of their last eight matches against Fiorentina in Serie A (D1 L1) and since the beginning of the 2020-21 season no team has beaten the Viola more times in the top-flight (Milan also six).
- Inter have won their last four away matches against Fiorentina in Serie A by an aggregate score of 10-4 and no team in the competition's history have ever achieved five away successes in a row against Viola.
- Fiorentina have won each of their last seven Serie A matches and could win eight top-flight games in a row for the second time in their history, previously doing so between February and April 1960 under Luis Carniglia.
- Inter have drawn their last two matches against teams starting the matchday in the top four positions of the Serie A table (4-4 against Juventus and 1-1 against Napoli); only once before have the Nerazzurri failed to win three consecutive such matches under manager Simone Inzaghi, doing so between January and February 2022 (0-0 against Atalanta, 1-2 against Milan and 1-1 against Napoli).
- Inter have scored 18 first half goals in Serie A this season with only Barcelona (20) scoring more goals before half-time across Europe's big five leagues.
- No team have scored more goals via set pieces than Fiorentina in the big five European leagues this season: 11 (level with Real Madrid) - five from corners, three from penalties, two from direct free kicks and one from a throw-in.
- Moise Kean (9 currently) could hit double figures for goals in a campaign in the big five European leagues for just the second time after the 13 he netted for PSG in 2020-21. The 24-year-old has recorded seven shots following a carry this season with only Jamie Gittens and Kylian Mbappé (both 8) doing so more often in such leagues.
- Lautaro Martínez has scored seven goals in his last five appearances against Fiorentina across all competitions; in fact, Viola are the team against which the Argentine has scored his most braces as an Inter player (3).
- Only Robert Lewandowski (5) has scored multiple goals in more games than Marcus Thuram (4) in Europe's big five leagues so far this season (Harry Kane also 4).

**Lecce - Juventus**

- Lecce have lost each of their last five Serie A matches against Juventus by an aggregate score of 11-1; the Giallorossi have never before suffered six consecutive losses against the Bianconeri in the top-flight (also five between 2004 and 2008).
- Juventus have won their last two away matches against Lecce in Serie A without conceding (1-0, 3-0) but the Old Lady have never recorded three consecutive clean sheets at Lecce's stadium in Serie A.
- Lecce – who won last time out at Venezia – could record back-to-back victories in Serie A for the first time since April (against Empoli and Sassuolo); Marco Giampaolo could become the first coach in Lecce's history to win both of his first two Serie A matches in charge of the Giallorossi.
- Juventus are one of the three remaining unbeaten teams in the big five European leagues this season (along with Bayern Munich and PSG) and also one of the two teams to have conceded the fewest goals this term (7 – level with Bayern).
- In each of the previous five Serie A seasons in which Juventus went unbeaten across their opening 13 games, they went on to win the Scudetto at the end of the season (most recently in 2019/20 under Maurizio Sarri).
- Should they draw with Lecce this weekend, Juventus would set a new club record for most Serie A draws in a single calendar year: they currently have 17 in 2024, a number only previously reached in 1956.
- Juventus have already recorded four 0-0 draws in the league this season, as many as across the entire 2023/24 Serie A campaign; the Bianconeri last had more goalless draws in a single Serie A season in 2011-12 (5 under Antonio Conte).
- In Kenan Yildiz (born in 2005) and Patrick Dorgu (born in 2004), the two youngest players to score three or more goals in Serie A this season will face off: for both, this is already their most prolific top-flight season (3 each).
- Only against Torino (5 goals, 1 assist) has Ante Rebic been directly involved in more goals in Serie A than Juventus (4 - 3 goals, 1 assist); against the Bianconeri, he averages one goal involvement every 60 minutes played in Serie A.
- Nicolò Fagioli's first Serie A goal came against Lecce back in October 2022; the Juventus midfielder has played only 16 minutes in the last four league matches (excluding stoppage time), after having played 232 minutes in the previous four.



Roma - Atalanta

2 December 2024



- Roma have picked up just one point in their last four Serie A fixtures against Atalanta (D1 L3) and across the 2022/23 and 2023/24 campaigns, Atalanta are the team against which the Giallorossi picked up the fewest points (1), amongst ever-present opponents.
- Roma have won just one of their last 10 home games against Atalanta in Serie A (1-0 in March 2022), recording five draws and four defeats in that period and never repeating the same result twice in a row (most recently a 1-1 draw).
- Roma have lost their last three league games and could suffer four defeats in a row in Serie A for the first time in 16 years, last doing so in November 2008 under Luciano Spalletti.
- Atalanta have won each of their last seven Serie A games and only once previously have they won more successive matches in the competition (9 between February and July 2020).
- With just 13 points, this is Roma's worst ever start to a Serie A campaign after 13 games in the three-points-for-a-winner; meanwhile this is Atalanta's best points return at this stage of such a season (28 points).
- Roma have recorded more high turnovers than any other team in Serie A this season (111) while they have also won possession in the final third (65) more often than any side; Atalanta meanwhile rank fifth for high turnovers (85) this term and third for the latter statistic (56 – Como on 59).
- Three of Atalanta's last six Serie A goals have come via crosses while no team has scored more goals from crosses in the competition overall this term (7 – level with Udinese).
- Lorenzo Pellegrini is yet to score in Serie A this season and not since the 2019-20 campaign has he waited longer for his first top-flight goal of a campaign (MD17); the Italian recorded five assists after 13 games that season however but has just one assist to his name this term.
- Mateo Retegui is the first player in Atalanta's history to score at least 12 goals across the Dea's first 13 matches of a Serie A campaign; overall, he is the fifth Italian player to reach this figure at this stage of a top-flight season this century after **Ciro Immobile** (2019/20 and 2017/18), **Luca Toni** (2005/06), **Christian Vieri** (2002/03) and **Dario Hubner** (2001/02).
- Ademola Lookman (0 goals in 48 minutes of Serie A action against Roma) has scored in his last two away Serie A appearances and could score in three straight away outings in the competition for the first time as an Atalanta player.
