Como - Inter 23 May 2025



- Inter have won each of their last eight Serie A matches against Como, conceding only two goals in that period; they have only had a longer winning streak in the competition against Empoli and Genoa (nine against both).
- After losing only two of their first 10 home matches against Inter in Serie A (W5, D3), Como have since lost each of their most recent three, with those coming between 1987 and 2002.
- Como have already secured 10th place in the standings and currently have 49 points; the last newly promoted team to win at least 50 points and end in 10th place were Hellas Verona in 2013/14 - Monza in 2022/23 finished 11th with 52 points.
- Como have won their last three home matches in Serie A and could become the first newly promoted team to win four consecutive home games since Hellas Verona in 2020 (four in a row between January and June).
- Inter could win the Scudetto with 81 points, an average of 2.1 points per game; since 1994/95 only Juventus in 1996/97 (1.9) have won the title with a points average below 2.1.
- After a run of eight consecutive away victories with seven clean sheets, Inter have since won only two of their last eight Serie A away matches (D3 L3); the Nerazzurri have kept nine away clean sheets this season with only Napoli (10) and Atalanta (11) recording more in the Italian top-flight this term.
- Across the top five European Leagues in 2024-25, Inter have scored more goals via set-pieces than any other side (25) while only Monza (5) have scored fewer than Como (6).
- Inter have scored 112 goals across all competitions in 2024/25 and only once have they netted more in a campaign since 1929/30 in 2019/20, when they scored 113 goals.
- Nico Paz has scored six goals and provided eight assists in Serie A this season and with a goal or an assist he would reach 15 goal involvements at the age of 20 years and 257 day; the last player aged younger able to take part in at least 15 goals in a Serie A season was Dejan Kulusevski with Parma in 2019/20 (20 years and 88 days).
- Denzel Dumfries has scored 11 goals and provided five assists this season across all competitions; the last Serie A defender to score more in a single season was Robin Gosens in 2020/21 (12 goals).

Napoli - Cagliari 23 May 2025



- After their win in the reverse fixture (4-0 in September), Napoli could win both of their matches against Cagliari in a Serie A season for the first time since 2018/19 under Carlo Ancelotti.
- The last three matches between Napoli and Cagliari played in the second half of the season in Serie A have all ended in a 1-1 draw including the most recent one in February 2024, with an equalising goal scored by Zito Luvumbo in the 96th minute after Victor Osimhen opened the scoring in the 65th minute.
- Napoli have won nine of their last 12 home matches against Cagliari in Serie A (D2 L1), scoring 30 goals in that period (2.5 on average per match) six of those have been played since matchday 30 (W5 D1 for the Partenopei).
- Napoli could win the Scudetto for the fourth time in their history after 1986/87, 1989/90 and 2022/23; so far no team from central-southern Italy has ever won the Scudetto more than three times (Roma also three).
- Napoli could become the first team in the history of a 20-team Serie A to win the Scudetto after a 10th place finish in the previous season, beating the record of Juventus under Antonio Conte in 2011/12, 7th in the previous campaign.
- With one match still to play, Cagliari have gained the same number of points as they did last season in Serie A (36); the Sardinians have lost both matches in the current league campaign against the team starting the matchday as the league leaders (0-1 vs Atalanta on 14 December 2024 and 1-3 vs Inter on 12 April).
- Napoli have scored 57 goals in the current league season and in the history of Serie A when played with 20 teams, the winner of Scudetto that scored the fewest goals was AC Milan in 2010/11 (65 goals).
- Napoli could become the third different team managed by Antonio Conte to win the Scudetto and he could become the
 first manager in Serie A history (since 1929/30) to win the title with three different clubs (Fabio Capello's titles in
 2004/05 and 2005/06 with Juventus are excluded).
- Romelu Lukaku's first Serie A start for Napoli was in the reverse game against Cagliari (on 15th September 2024), when
 he scored once and provided two assists (4-0). In the calendar year 2025, the Belgian has been involved in nine goals
 in home games (5G+4A), the most of any player in Serie A this calendar year ahead of Scott McTominay (7 5G+2A).
- Roberto Piccoli scored his 10th goal of the season last time out against Venezia; among forwards with at least 10 goals in the big five European leagues in 2024/25, only Patrik Schick (21G, 0A) and Kike García (13G, 0A) have provided fewer assists than him (one).

Bologna - Genoa

24 May 2025



- Bologna have won just one of their last 11 Serie A games against Genoa (D5 L5); since the 2018/19 season, the Emilians
 have only achieved fewer top-flight wins against Juventus (D6 L8) and Benevento (D1 L1).
- Bologna have not won at home against Genoa in the top-flight since February 2018, having won just three points and suffered two defeats in the five matches since; the Emilian team only currently have a longer winless streak at home in Serie A only against Napoli (6) and Juventus (22).
- Bologna have lost their last two Serie A games, as many as across their previous nine games in the competition; the Emilians have not suffered three consecutive league defeats since January 2022.
- Only Roma (26) have won more Serie A points at home in 2025 than Bologna (24), who remain unbeaten in the league on home turf this calendar year (W7 D3).
- Genoa have lost four of their last five league games (D1), as many defeats as across their previous 15 games in the
 competition (W6 D5); the Ligurians could earn one point or fewer from their last six Serie A games of a season for the
 first time since 1991/92 (six defeats in that case).
- Genoa have failed to win any of their last 10 away league games (D5 L5); October 2009-April 2010 was the last time the
 Ligurians went on a longer winless run on the road under the guidance of a single coach in Serie A (12 away games
 without a win under Gian Piero Gasperini).
- Genoa are the team that have scored the fewest goals from outside the box in Serie A this season with their sole goal from distance coming against Bologna in the reverse fixture through Andrea Pinamonti.
- Riccardo Orsolini has scored 14 goals in Serie A this season, two of which have come in the last two games; the Bologna
 player has already scored in three games in a row this season (four between October and November) and could be the
 first rossoblù player to reach 15 goals in a single Serie A season since Marco Di Vaio in 2010/11 (19).
- Aarón Martín has provided seven assists in Serie A this season and the last Genoa player to record more in a campaign
 was Andrea Bertolacci in 2014/15 (eight); he has provided an assist in each of his last three appearances and the last
 rossoblù player to do so in four Serie A appearances in a row was Rodrigo Palacio between May and September 2011.
- Andrea Pinamonti, who scored a brace last time out to reach 10 Serie A goals for the season, could become the only Italian to surpass 10 goals in three of the last four Serie A seasons; considering all nationalities, only Lautaro Martínez, Olivier Giroud, Victor Osimhen and Ademola Lookman have managed to do so.

Milan - Monza 24 May 2025



- There have been no draws between Milan and Monza in their five Serie A meetings, with the Rossoneri claiming four wins and suffering one defeat to the Brianzoli; these five matches have also had an average of 3.2 goals scored per game.
- The two Serie A matches played at the San Siro between Milan and Monza have been won by the Rossoneri by an aggregate score of 7-1; only against Atalanta (10) and Roma (8) have the Brianzoli conceded more away goals in the top-flight.
- Milan are guaranteed to finish the Serie A season outside of the qualification places for any European competition for the first time since 2015/16, when they ended 7th in the standings.
- Milan have lost 16 games in 2024/25 across all competitions and only in three previous seasons in their entire history have they recorded more defeats (since 1929/30): 17 in each of 2013/14, 1996/97 and 1973/74.
- Milan have won only eight home matches in the league this season (D7 L3) and across the previous 20 seasons (since 2004/05), only twice did they fail to achieve at least nine home wins in a single Serie A campaign: eight in both 2007/08 and 2020/21.
- Should they lost this match, Monza will end the season with just 18 points: in the three points for a win era, only four teams have finished a Serie A season with fewer: Brescia 12 in 1994/95, Napoli 14 in 1997/98, Ancona 13 in 2003/04 and Salernitana 17 in 2023/24.
- Monza won their last away match (2-1 vs Udinese) after suffering 10 consecutive defeats away from home in Serie A
 prior; the Brianzoli haven't recorded two away wins in a row in the league since doing so between February and March
 2024 (against Salernitana and Genoa).
- Gianluca Caprari has been involved in a goal in both of his last two Serie A appearances (one goal, one assist) and he
 could be involved in at least one goal in three games in a row in the competition for the first time since doing so between
 January and February 2022 for Hellas Verona (4 in a row).
- Monza are one of the two teams (along with Empoli) against which Tijjani Reijnders has scored more than one goal in Serie A (2 vs both); with 10 goals and four assists, the Dutchman could become the first AC Milan central midfielder to be involved in at least 15 goals in a top-flight campaign since Franck Kessie in 2020/21 (17).
- With a goal in this match Christian Pulisic would equal his own scoring record in a season in the big five European leagues (12 with AC Milan in 2023/24), while with a goal or assist he would surpass his record for goal involvements in these competitions with his 20 in the 2024/25 Serie A campaign (11G 9A) the same as he managed in 2023-24 (12G 8A).

Atalanta - Parma 25 May 2025



- Atalanta have won their last seven Serie A games against Parma, with an aggregate score of 24-5; they have never won eight consecutive games against a single opponent in the top-flight (seven also against Bologna and Sassuolo).
- Parma have picked up just one point in their last nine Serie A games against Atalanta; in the period (since 2014/15 season), among the teams they have faced in more than two seasons the Gialloblu have obtained their fewest points against the Dea.
- Atalanta have won each of their last four home games against Parma in Serie A without conceding a goal: this is already
 the longest streak of consecutive home wins with clean sheets against a single side for the Dea in the competition.
- Parma haven't lost in six of their seven Serie A games under Cristian Chivu against teams that started the MD in the top half of the table (W2 D4) the only exception was a defeat against Udinese on 1st March 2025 (0-1).
- Parma will be safe if they win this match or if they don't win against Atalanta and if only one among Lecce and Empoli
 win their games; if they finish level on points with Hellas Verona and the two teams that currently follow the Gialloblù
 in the standing (Lecce and Empoli, who should both win), the Ducali would go to the playoff match to avoid relegation
 against Hellas Verona.
- If they win this match, Atalanta will gain 77 points in the standings, one point fewer than their record in a single Serie A season: 78, recorded in both 2019/20 and 2020/21. In addition, the Dea (34 goals conceded in 2024/25) could record their fewest goals conceded in a 20-team Serie A season (their best result so far at the end of a season are 39 goals conceded in 2017/18).
- Atalanta have scored the most goals from outside the box in the current league season: 12, including three of their last four goals; they finished with 13 goals outside the box in each of their previous two campaigns in Serie A.
- Mateo Retegui Atalanta's all-time top scorer in a single Serie A campaign has been involved in 32 goals in the
 current league season (25G+7A): among the players in the Big-5 European leagues in 2024/25 with at least 20 goals
 scored, only Mohamed Salah (18), Omar Marmoush (nine) and Harry Kane (eight) have provided more assists than him
 (seven).
- Ibrahim Sulemana has scored from outside the box in the last two games (v Roma and Genoa); in the last 20 Serie A seasons, only two players have scored from outside the box in three consecutive appearances: Cengiz Ünder in February 2018 and Radja Nainggolan between November and December 2019.
- Among goalkeepers born since 2002 this season in the Big-5 European leagues, Parma's Zion Suzuki has made the most saves (98).

Empoli - Hellas Verona 25 May 2025



- Empoli won the first leg against Hellas Verona (4-1 on 8 December 2024) and in Serie A they have only won two games in a row against the Scaligeri once: in the 2015/16 season under Marco Giampaolo.
- The first leg against Empoli was one of four matches this season in which Hellas Verona conceded at least four goals in the first half; in the current Big-5 Leagues, only relegated Holstein Kiel (42) have conceded more goals than the Venetians (41, equal with Southampton) in the first half.
- After recording three draws and three defeats in their first six away games against Empoli in Serie A, Hellas Verona won their most recent one: 1-0 on 19 August 2023, with a goal from Federico Bonazzoli.
- Empoli will be safe on the last day if they beat Hellas Verona and one of Lecce and Parma does not win; in the event of a draw, the Tuscans would certainly be saved only if Lecce loses against Lazio and Venezia does not win against Juventus.
- Hellas Verona will only need to avoid losing to ensure their permanence in Serie A, an event that would also occur, regardless of the result of the Gialloblù, if Lecce do not win against Lazio; in the event of a defeat for the Venetians and a simultaneous success for the Giallorossi, Hellas would avoid the play-off only if Parma were to lose against Atalanta.
- After a 20-game winless streak in Serie A, in which Empoli had picked up just six points (L14), the Tuscan team have now won two in a row and could make it three in the competition for the first time since May 2019, when they won on matchdays 35, 36 and 37.
- Hellas Verona have drawn five of their last eight Serie A games (D3), including their last two. The Venetians are unbeaten in the two matches they have faced teams that started the day in the relegation zone this calendar year (1-1 vs Venezia, 1-0 vs Monza).
- Empoli have conceded the joint-most goals by substitutes in Serie A this season (14, level with Monza), while Hellas Verona have scored nine of their 32 total goals by subs-on players (28%), a percentage lower only than Lazio (34%).
- Lorenzo Colombo one step away from 100 Serie A appearances (99 so far) has scored three goals against Hellas Verona in the tournament, including his only brace in the topflight (3-1 win against Monza on 5 November 2023): the Gialloblù are his favourite target in the competition.
- Darko Lazovic has been involved in three goals (one goal and two assists) in his last four Serie A matches against Empoli; the 1990-born player could also score in consecutive games for the first time ever in the Italian topflight.

Lazio - Lecce 25 May 2025



- Lazio have won their last two Serie A games against Lecce and have not achieved three consecutive wins against them
 in the competition since between 2001 and 2004, when they collected four victories in a row under Alberto Zaccheroni
 first and then Roberto Mancini.
- Lazio have faced Lecce 17 times at home in Serie A, losing only once (W11 D5); the Biancocelesti have had fewer home defeats against teams they have faced at least 15 times at home in the competition only against Empoli (W11 D4).
- Since mid-February onwards, Lazio have drawn eight of their 13 Serie A matches (W4 L1), more than any other team in the competition during this period.
- Lazio have drawn each of their last six home Serie A games, the longest ongoing run of home draws in the competition; furthermore, the Biancocelesti have only managed seven consecutive draws at home in 1989.
- Lecce won their last league match, after a run of 13 games without a win (D5, L8) and have not achieved consecutive wins in Serie A since April 2024.
- Lecce have scored exactly one goal in each of their last four away games in Serie A; the last time they have scored in five consecutive away games in a single season was September-November 2019.
- Lecce must win against Lazio to be certain of safety, while in the event of a draw or defeat their fate will depend on the other matches. A draw would be enough for the Biancocelesti to be certain of sixth place.
- Lazio have scored 22 goals in the last 15 minutes of play, more than any other team in this championship, while Lecce have scored five in the same period, only Empoli (three) have done worse.
- Pedro, who scored a brace in the last league match against Inter, has reached double figures for goals in this
 championship, at the age of 37 years and 294 days, becoming the sixth oldest player to reach 10 goals in a single Serie
 A season, after Zlatan Ibrahimovic, Silvio Piola, Fabio Quagliarella, Pietro Ferraris and Luca Toni.
- Nikola Krstovic has scored a goal and provided an assist in his last two league games, after having had no goal involvements in the previous five; the Lecce striker is currently on 15 in total (11G+4A) and the last Giallorossi player to do better in a Serie A season was Marco Mancosu (16 in 2019/20).

Torino - Roma 25 May 2025



- Torino have won just one of their last 10 games against Roma in Serie A (D2 L7), losing their last two; the Granata have
 not suffered three defeats in a row against the Giallorossi in the competition since a run of five between 2017 and 2019.
- Roma have won both matches against Torino played on matchday 38 in Serie A, winning 3-2 at home in May 2009 and 3-0 away in May 2022.
- Roma have won five of their last seven away games against Torino in Serie A (D1 L1), as many as their previous 19
 away games against the Granata in the competition beforehand (W5 D10 L4).
- Torino have suffered two consecutive defeats (0-2 vs Inter and 0-1 vs Lecce). Indeed, under Paolo Vanoli's management, they have already suffered three consecutive defeats in Serie A twice, most recently between October and November 2024 against Roma, Fiorentina and Juventus, also failing to score in those three games.
- Should Juventus fail to win and Roma win on the final day, the Giallorossi would close out the Serie A season by
 qualifying for the Champions League for the first time since 2017/18, which was also the last time they finished above
 5th in the top-flight (3rd).
- Roma have obtained 46 of their current 66 points in Serie A this season in 2025; this calendar year, only Barcelona (47) have earned more points in the big-five European leagues than Roma (Bayern Munich also 46).
- Roma have scored eight goals from corners in Serie A this season (including one in the previous matchday, via Gianluca Mancini against Milan), with only Inter (12) scoring more (Parma and Udinese also 8).
- Ché Adams, who has scored nine goals in Serie A in 2024/25 for Torino, could reach double figures for goals in a season
 in the big-five European leagues for the first time in his career; however, only two of the Scotsman's nine goals this term
 have come against teams currently in the top half of the table (vs Atalanta and Lazio in August and September).
- With his goal in the last round against Milan, Bryan Cristante equalled his highest scoring tally in a Serie A season with Roma (4 goals, level with 2018/19, his first season with the Giallorossi); he has only scored more in a single campaign in the competition with Atalanta in 2017/18 (9 goals).
- Since the beginning of February since when he has played 14 of Roma's 15 Serie A games, all as a starter Matías Soulé has created the most big chances for his teammates (8) and attempted the most dribbles (59) in the competition.

Udinese - Fiorentina

25 May 2025



- Udinese have won three of their last six Serie A games against Fiorentina (D1 L2), as many as in their previous 17 games against the Viola in the competition (D4 L10).
- Fiorentina have kept as many clean sheets in their last seven away Serie A games at Udinese (4) as they had in their previous 31 beforehand.
- Since mid-March, Udinese have lost seven of their nine matches in Serie A (W1 D1); in this period, no team has suffered more defeats than the Bianconeri in Serie A, and no team has won fewer points (4).
- After a run of three consecutive home wins in the league, Udinese have won just one point in their last four home games, suffering three defeats, as many as in their previous eight beforehand (W3 D2).
- Fiorentina currently have 62 points, while on the seven occasions in which they have surpassed this figure at the end of a Serie A season since 2006/07, they have always qualified for European competition.
- After losing just three of their first 11 away games this season (W5 D3), Fiorentina have suffered five defeats in their last seven away league games (W1 D1), including the most recent two against Roma and Venezia.
- In addition to being, along with Napoli, one of the two teams with the fewest headed goals conceded (1), Udinese are third behind Cagliari (28%) and Genoa (24%) for percentage of goals scored via headers in Serie A this season (23%, 9/39).
- Udinese's Lorenzo Lucca found the net in his last Serie A match against Monza; the last time he scored in two consecutive matches in the competition was in February against Roma and Venezia, both at home.
- In addition to having scored four goals, his personal best in a single Serie A season, Rolando Mandragora has provided three assists in the competition this term; only in 2022/23 (4) has he provided more in a season in the competition.
- Moise Kean has scored 18 goals and provided three assists in Serie A this season, a total of 21 goal involvements, just
 two less than he managed in all of his previous six Serie A seasons combined (22 goals, one assist). The last Italian to
 record more in a campaign with Fiorentina was Luca Toni in 2005/06 (37, 31 goals and 6 assists).

Venezia - Juventus

25 May 2025



- After losing only one of their first seven matches against Juventus in Serie A (W1 D5), Venezia have lost 16 of their last 20 against them in the division (W1 D3); only AC Milan (18) won more games against the Lagunari than the Bianconeri (17) in the top-flight.
- Venezia's last home win against Juventus in Serie A was in April 1962; since then, there have been four Bianconeri wins
 and two draws in this exact fixture. However, these two teams could draw two consecutive matches at the Lagunari's
 home for the first time since 1940.
- Venezia have not repeated the same result twice in a row in their last nine league matches (W2 D4 L3), losing at Cagliari
 in the most recent.
- Venezia won two of their last three home league games (L1), including their most recent, as many as in their previous 13 beforehand (D5 L6); they could win two consecutive home matches in Serie A for the first time since January 2000 under Luciano Spalletti.
- Juventus have both won and kept a clean sheet on the final MD in each of the last two league seasons; the last time
 they had three clean sheets in a row in the last match of a season in Serie A was between 1980-1982, the only time they
 have done so in their history.
- Juventus haven't won any of their four away league matches under Igor Tudor (D3 L1); the last Juventus coach to fail
 to win any of his first five Serie A away matches in charge was Cestmir Vycpalek (five draws in 1971).
- 53% of the goals scored by Venezia in Serie A this season have been from set pieces (16/30), a league-high in 2024/25; on the other hand, only Como (12%) had a lower ratio in the current campaign than Juventus (16%).
- Hans Nicolussi Caviglia, who has scored two goals via direct free kicks in Serie A this season (more than any other player), played 11 matches with Juventus in the top flight between 2018/19 and 2023/24.
- With two assists in the last MD, Kenan Yildiz has been directly involved in 10 goals in Serie A this season (6 goals, 4 assists), becoming the youngest player to reach double figures in the division this term. With him as a starter, Juventus have a points-per-game average of 2.1 this season, which drops to less than half that (1.0) in the 10 matches in which he has not been in the starting line-up.
- In the last MD, Dusan Vlahovic scored after a run of seven league matches without a goal; before this goalless period, he scored in two appearances in a row against Cagliari and Empoli in February.
